#### **FIVE ELEMENTS: BASIC PRINCIPLES**



This begins a series of brief articles on the Five Elements. Each article will provide a brief outline of the major correspondences for each element. This particular article will focus on the two major flows in the five Element model — the Generation Cycle and the Control/ Mitigation Cycle.

The Five Elements are called more appropriately the Five Phases, or the Five Stations. The reason for this are the two main connecting paths between each stage. Neither one of these paths stops at any one phase, each continues one to another phase.

The Generation/Creation Cycle flows clockwise from one phase to the next phase. Thus, it goes from Fire to Earth, Earth, Earth to Metal, Metal to Water, Water to Wood, Wood to Fire, and so on. Each phase gives birth to the next phase. Fire burns down leaving ashes which become part of the Earth. Earth embodies and gives up of shape. Metal, in the form of minerals and rock,

We want to train additional faculty and have prepared the *Leader's Program* to do this. You need to have the following qualities and abilities:

- Experience in teaching and enrolling Touch For Health/Educational Kinesiology (rosters sent to the Foundation, please).
- A clear knowledge of what is Touch for Health and what is not.
- A deep commitment to the ideals of Touch For Health and to making touch healing widely available.

The program consists of attending the Facilitator Program in each of the following capacities: first as a participant, then as a course assistant and finally as a co-instructor. In addition you need to complete the Kinetic Education Instructor Training and a training workshop designed specifically for Facilitator Program leaders. The FPL Workshop will be held once a year, the next one being this winter. 
# JOHN VARUN MAGUIRE JOINS THE U.S. FACULTY AND TFH STAFF

# ERTIFICATION: WHAT DOES IT MEAN?





Many people have inquired at the Foundation in recent months about becoming certified so that they can

"do" Touch For Health legally or properly. Other people have said that they really need to take classes so that they can qualify to "do" Touch for Health and Educational Kinesiology. These inquiries reflect a nebulous understanding of the situation, both legally and ethically. In all Touch For Health Foundation workshops, participants have always signed a declaration that they recognize that Touch For Health is not a cure or treatment for any disease or condition, and they will not be licensed to diagnose or treat any particular symptoms.

Of course, if you are already licensed to practice, you may use Touch For Health as an extension of your professional skills. But Touch For Health training, Educational Kinesiology training or any of the other vocational trainings do not qualify a person to treat people. The law in your jurisdiction may be different, but in California, the law includes any type of treatment, for any condition, including low energy or postural imbalance.

In recent years there has been a movement among bodywork professionals and kinesiologists to push for the establishment of a new profession that is recognized and is able to operate with third party insurance claims, etc. It is not the Foundation's policy to support such a move. We believe the health/disease care system in this country is already overburdened and has difficulty serving people properly, because of the inherent imbalance in the treatment model.

Licensing and certification often works in the reverse to what was originally intended. The "official" nature of the license ends up as a protection for the incompetent practitioner, rather than a protection for the so-called "gullible public."

The certification that the Touch For Health Foundation offers is a California State Vocational Educational Certification. The Touch For Health Foundation is officially a vocational school training people for the vocation of Touch For Health Instructor or Kinetic Education Instructor in the State of California. The Certificate is not necessarily valid in other states or countries.

Your certification to teach Touch For Health also gives you the opportunity to promote your classes as a certified TFH instructor, demonstrating that you have had qualified instruction and can grant certificates of completion to your students.

mitigates Wood in that it sets boundaries of growth for Wood and plant life. Wood mitigates the Earth phase by holding Earth in its' place. Earth modifies Water's abilities to flow freely by providing banks and channels, thus giving Water shape and form. Water checks the wanton spread of Fire by "cooling" it.

Each of these cycles is important by itself, and even more so in combination with the other. If growth and creation remain unchecked, life could easily die of over-abundance. If everything were tightly controlled, then life would die for lack of growth. Together the two phases work in a dynamic interchange and flow. Neither cycle pre-dominating for very long over the other. Each cycle having its' unique effect on the system as a whole, then relinquishing to the next.

This concludes this brief synopsis on the Five Elements. The next article will be on the Fire Element.



#### States May Regulate Medical Practice But They May Not Deny Access To Alternative Forms of Health Care

In declaring unconstitutional that part of the Texas Medical Practice Act, and regulations promulgated persuant thereto, which limited the practice of acupuncture to licensed physicians, U.S. District Judge Gabrielle McDonald outlines the various options available to States to deal with alternative health care therapies:

"So long as it does not significantly interfere with the decision to obtain the treatment, the State of Texas is, of course, free to deal with acupuncture as it chooses. It may accord to acupuncturists, as it does to chiroprac-

tors, full independent professional status. It may allow acupuncturists to practice independently of licensed physicians, but require diagnosis by or referral from such physicians. It may establish appropriate minumum standards of skill and knowledge to be met by those who practice acupuncture. It may even, if it considers such a framework feasible, require acupuncturists to practice under the supervision and control of licensed physicians....It may choose to regulate acupuncture in some entirely different fashion, or not at all. What it may not do, what it has done in the present case, is to unnecessarily render acupuncture treatment essentially unavailable. That the Constitution prohibits."


#### Alternatives to Orthodoxy Yield Progress

In a frequently quoted passage from Chief Justice Rose Bird's dissenting opinion in the *Privitera* laetrile case, the writer succinctly states the position advanced by alternative health practitioners who are challenging restrictive controls at the hands of state medical societies:

To require state approval before advising — prescribing — administering — a new treatment modality for an informed consenting patient is to suppress innovation by the person best qualified to make medical progress. The treating doctor, the clinician, is at the cutting edge of medical knowledge.

To require the doctor to use only orthodox "state sanctioned" methods of treatment under threat of criminal penalty for variance is to invite a repetition in California of the Soviet experience with "Lysenkoism." The mention of a requirement that licensed doctors must prescribe, treat, within "state sanctioned alternatives" raises the spector of medical stagnation at best, statism, paternalistic Big Brother at worst. It is by the alternatives to orthodoxy that medical progress has been made. A free, progressive society has an enormous stake in recognizing and protecting this right of the physician. People v.
